These updates are not meant for self-promotion, but in the last months we have received several inquiries from students asking us to outline what is included in our fees (and what's not). We therefore thought it important to make you aware of this as well so you can better inform the students on your campuses as they research their various program options and compare program fees. As always, please check our website or contact individual program coordinators for details regarding specific program features. As a general guide, however, all Arcadia Programs include:

- Tuition
- Guaranteed housing (program fees do not include meals except where noted)
- Weekend and day excursions (many cultural exploration programs are included in the program fee, others are offered at a reduced or subsidized rate)
- Thorough, 3 -4 day orientation in-country, administered by on-site Arcadia staff (in addition to orientation conducted in coordination with a partner institution)
- Health and accident insurance
- ISIC card
- Arcadia University transcript
- Complete pre-departure and continuous in-country advising and support
- Close attention to the health and safety of our program participants (including safety and security management and plans and the safe and security of Arcadia housing).
- Optional group flight arrangements
